ar owners are warned of a resurgence in vehicle recall scams during which criminals pose as officials representing a carmaker or tracking company.

The nonprofit company Insurance Crime Bureau (ICB) says criminals convince owners their vehicle is part of a batch being recalled for a malfunction or mechanical fault. They arrange for the vehicle to be fetched by a tow truck or a flatbed – and that's the last you see of your car.

"What makes the scam believable is that the scammers know your registration number and personal info," says Wynand van Vuuren, client experience partner at King Price
